

Accessibility Statement

The Bergbahnen Fieberbrunn GmbH is committed to making its website www.fieberbrunn.com accessible in accordance with the **Web Accessibility Act (WZG)**, implementing **Directive (EU) 2016/2102** of the European Parliament and of the Council.

Status of compliance with the requirements

This website is currently **only partially compliant** with conformance level AA of the “Web Content Accessibility Guidelines – WCAG 2.1” as well as the applicable European standards according to EN 301 549.

Non-accessible content

The following contents are not fully accessible:

a) Non-compliance with accessibility requirements

- Some images and icons lack alternative texts or are insufficiently described.
- Some texts have insufficient color contrast.
- Full keyboard navigation is not possible, especially in the main menu.
- Heading structures are not always implemented correctly.
- Form input fields are not always properly labeled.
- Embedded videos do not provide subtitles or audio descriptions.
- PDF documents are not fully accessible.

b) Disproportionate burden

- Older PDF and Office documents cannot currently be provided in an accessible format for economic and organizational reasons.

c) Content outside the scope of applicable legislation

- Third-party content integrated into the website (e.g. external widgets, maps) is outside our control and therefore excluded from the requirements.

Justification for partial compliance

The website is currently undergoing a **relaunch process together with Saalbach**, in which the implementation of digital accessibility is a central focus. The new website will be designed according to **WCAG 2.2 AA** and **EN 301 549** standards.

This statement was prepared on **27 August 2025**.
The assessment is based on an internal review.
